The property proposed for detachment is described as follows:

The Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW¼ NE¼), the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE¼ NE¼) EXCEPT the East 100 feet of the NE¼ of NE¼; the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE¼ NW¼); the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE¼ NW¼); and Government Lot One (1), all in Section Seven (7), Township Fifty-five (55), Range Twenty-four (24), West of the Fourth Principal Meridian, and

The East One Hundred Feet (E. 100') of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄), the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW¹/₄ NE¹/₄), and the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄), all in Section Seven (7), Township Fifty-five (55), Range Twenty-four (24), West of the Fourth Principal Meridian.

After all testimony is complete and the record is closed, the Chief Administrative Law Judge will issue findings and an order in accordance with Minnesota Statutes Chapter 414. Any other person, group of persons, or governmental agency residing in, owning property in, or exercising jurisdiction over the subject area that submits a timely request, and is determined by the presiding judge to have a direct legal interest that will be affected by the outcome of this proceeding may become a party.
