NOTICE OF HEARING

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414, as amended, before the Chief Administrative Law Judge, in the above-entitled matter.

The first hearing will convene at 9:00 a.m. on June 19, 2014, in the Main Conference Room, Hutchinson City Hall, 111 Hassan Street SE, Hutchinson, Minnesota 55350. The evidentiary part of the hearing will be held at a later date. All persons shall be given an opportunity to be heard orally and to submit written data, statements, or arguments concerning the above-entitled matter when this hearing is reconvened by an administrative law judge. The right to testify and the admission of testimony and other evidence shall be governed by the Rules of the Office of Administrative Hearings, Municipal Boundary Adjustments, Chapter 6000 and any other Statutes or rules that may be applicable.

The property proposed for detachment is described as follows:

Parcel # 1 PID R23.249.0020 is 25.87 acres legal description is Seltz subdivision lot-002, block-001 is located in the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of section 32 of Hutchinson Township and the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 33 of Hutchinson Township


Parcel #2 PID R23.249.0040 is 15.5 acres legal description is Seltz subdivision lot-002 block-002 is located in the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of section 33 of Hutchinson Township

After all testimony is complete and the record is closed, the Chief Administrative

Law Judge will issue findings and an order in accordance with Minnesota Statutes Chapter 414. Any other person, group of persons, or governmental agency residing in, owning property in, or exercising jurisdiction over the subject area that submits a timely request, and is determined by the presiding judge to have a direct legal interest that will be affected by the outcome of this proceeding may become a party. A party bears a portion of the hearing costs.
