- 1. On April 22, 2014, a petition for detachment of more than 40 acres from the City of Silver Bay was submitted to the Office of Administrative Hearings-Municipal Boundary Adjustment Unit. The petition was submitted by more than 75 percent of the property owners.
- 2. On May 7, 2014, a resolution opposing the detachment petition was received from the City of Silver Bay.
- 3. On May 15, 2014, a resolution opposing the detachment was received from Beaver Bay Township.
 - 4. Minn. Stat. § 414.06, subd. 2 states, in part:

If both the municipality and town submit a resolution opposing the petition, a hearing must not be held and the chief administrative law judge shall deny the petition.

Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 414.06, subd. 2, the petition for detachment is **DENIED**.
