#### City of Long Beach Resolution No. 56

JOINT RESOLUTION REQUESTING CONCURRENT DETACHMENT FROM CITY OF LONG BEACH AND ANNEXATION TO CITY OF GLENWOOD OF CERTAIN PROPERTY LOCATED IN CITY OF LONG BEACH PURSUANT TO MN STATUTE 414.061.

Whereas, certain real property for concurrent detachment and annexation (hereinafter "Property") legally described as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof is approximately 15.1 acres in size and depicted on the map attached as Exhibit "B-1" and Exhibit "B-2" and located within the boundaries of the City of Long Beach;

Whereas, the State of Minnesota, through its Department of Natural Resources, (hereinafter "DNR") owns and operates a regional office complex located within the City of Long Beach on real property lying immediately adjacent to the border of the City of Glenwood; and

Whereas, the DNR is proposing to construct a new 8828 square foot regional office building on a portion of that real property; and

Whereas, the proposed project will involve the complete removal of an existing farm house currently used by DNR as office space; and

Whereas, the City of Long Beach does offer sewer services within its municipality, however does not provide service to the real property described herein; and

Whereas, the current DNR regional office building complex is not supplied with municipal water from the City of Long Beach; and

**Whereas,** the current DNR regional office building complex is provided sewer services by the City of Glenwood; and

Whereas, the City of Glenwood does provide municipal water and sewer services to its commercial, industrial, and residential population; and

**Whereas,** the DNR wishes to utilize both municipal water and sewer services for its new regional office building; and

Whereas, the City of Glenwood is agreeable to annexation of the real property described below in order to provide all necessary municipal services to the proposed DNR regional office building; and

**Whereas,** the City of Long Beach does not oppose the annexation of the real property described below in order to provide the necessary municipal services to the proposed DNR regional office building; and

Whereas, the City of Glenwood and the City of Long Beach deem it necessary and appropriate that they work together to develop and implement a process for the orderly and controlled growth of both Cities; and

Whereas, the City of Glenwood and the City of Long Beach agree that the extension of municipal water service to the proposed DNR regional office building is in the best interests of the entire community; and

Whereas, Minnesota Statutes, Section 414.061 authorizes municipalities to concurrently detach and annex; and

Whereas, the City of Glenwood and the City of Long Beach have reached an agreement which is in the best interests of citizens of both Cities.

**Now, therefore, be it resolved,** by the City of Glenwood and the City of Long Beach that the parties enter into this Joint Resolution and agree to the following:

1. <u>Description of the Area to be concurrently detached and annexed.</u> The following described area is property subject to concurrent detachment and annexation under and pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 414.061, and the parties do hereby designate these areas for concurrent detachment and annexation as provided by statute:

That area legally described on the attached Exhibit A and set forth on the map attached as Exhibit B.

- 2. <u>Detachment of Area.</u> The City of Long Beach may, by resolution, detach the land described above.
- 3. <u>Annexation of Area.</u> The City of Glenwood may, by resolution, annex the land described above.
- 4. <u>Compliance with Minnesota Law.</u> By execution of this Joint Resolution, the City of Glenwood and the City of Long Beach acknowledge that they have complied with all requirements of Minnesota law pertaining to adoption of this Joint Resolution, including publishing notice of the Joint Resolution.
- 5. <u>Joint Request.</u> That the City of Long Beach and the City of Glenwood jointly request that the Office of Administrative Hearings Municipal Boundary Adjustments concurrently detach the property from the City of Long Beach and annex the same to the City of Glenwood at its earliest possible date.
- 6. <u>Municipal Board Jurisdiction.</u> Upon approval by the parties, this Joint Resolution shall confer jurisdiction upon the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH") so as to accomplish said orderly annexation in accordance with the terms of this Joint Resolution.



That part of Government Lot 5, Section 11, Township 125 North, Range 38 West, Pope County, Minnesota, described as follows:
