The reasons for wishing to continue with dissolution of the City of Kingston are as follows:

- Increasing rules and regulations are placing more demands on small cities. It is becoming more difficult to find workers.
- Many small neighboring communities in Meeker County such as Forest City, Manannah and Greenleaf are not incorporated and have the same services provided that the City of Kingston has.
- All of our services, such as law enforcement, road maintenance, and building inspections are presently contracted through Meeker County. Dassel Fire Department provides our fire protection. These services will remain the same if the city would be governed under Kingston Township.
- Many of the citizens of the City feel that there is no need for a city government when the city in fact does nothing more than what the township would do.

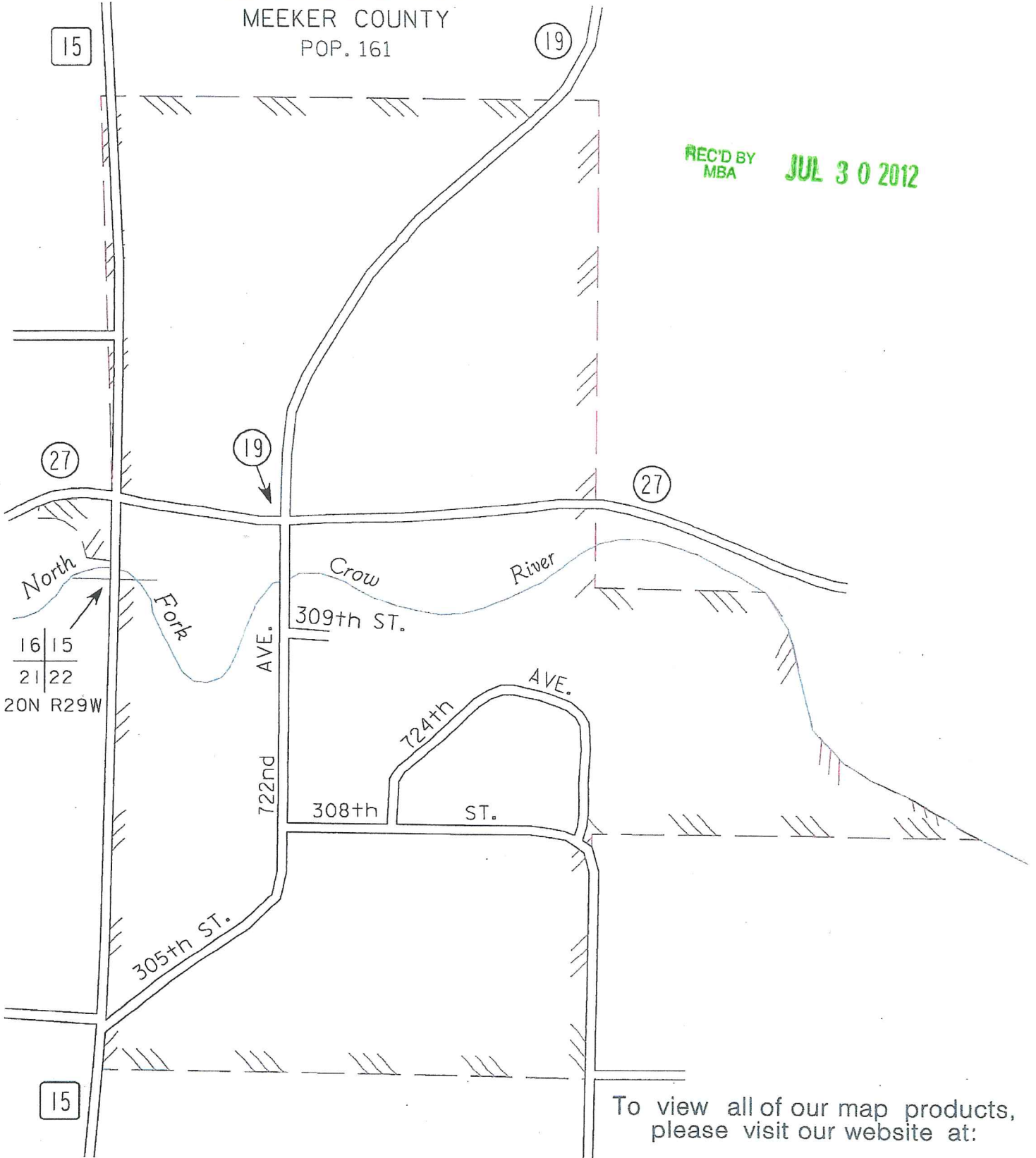
