ORDER

WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of Buffalo and the Town of Buffalo; and

WHEREAS, a resolution was received from the City of Buffalo indicating their desire that certain property be annexed to the City of Buffalo pursuant to M.S. 414.0325; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Director of Strategic and Long Range Planning may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation of land pursuant to said subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, Reorganization Order No. 192, effective March 8, 2005, has transferred the duties of the Director to the Chief Administrative Law Judge; and

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2007, the Chief Administrative Law Judge has reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in accordance with the terms of the joint resolution to the City of Buffalo, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof;

The Easterly 341.65 feet of the Southerly 510 feet of the North Half of the

Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 18, Township 120,
Range 25, Wright County, Minnesota.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That pursuant to Minn. Stat. 414.036, the Town of Buffalo will be reimbursed by the City of Buffalo in accordance with the terms of the Joint Resolution signed by the City of Buffalo on May 7, 2007 and the Town of Buffalo on May 1, 2007.
