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WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of Maple Lake and the Town of Maple Lake; and

WHEREAS, said joint resolution requests that certain property be annexed to the City of Maple Lake pursuant to M.S. 414.0325; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Director of Strategic and Long Range Planning may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation of land pursuant to said subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, on November 10, 2004, the Director has reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

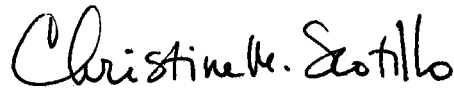
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in accordance with the terms of the joint resolution to the City of Maple Lake, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

All that part of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 6, Township 120, Range 26, described as follows: Begin at the point of intersection of the East line of said Section 6, and the centerline of County Road as now traveled distant 25.7 feet South of the Northeast corner of said Section 6, thence S. 2°02' East along said East line of

Section 6 distant 439.6 feet to the center of open ditch as now constructed, thence Northwesterly along the center of said ditch on the following described courses: North 84° 44' West, 332.75 feet, North 38° 51' West, 314.3 feet to the center of said County Road, thence Northeasterly along said center of County Road 539.9 feet more or less to the point of beginning.
