RESOLUTION No. 15-106

Councilor Webster offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the City of New Ulm and Cottonwood Township of Brown County, Minnesota entered into a Joint Resolution for Orderly Annexation approved by the City of New Ulm on April 12, 2006 and by Cottonwood Township on April 12, 2006 (the "Joint Resolution") pursuant to which areas designated in such Joint Resolution would be annexed to the City of New Ulm by resolution of the City's City Council upon the occurrence of specific events as designated therein;

WHEREAS, said Joint Resolution was accepted by the State of Minnesota on May 11, 2006 and was designated OA-1260;

WHEREAS, the City of New Ulm has received a petition for annexation of property within the area designated and defined in the Joint Resolution and located in Section 4, Township 109 North, Range 30 West, Brown County, Minnesota;

- 1. Which property is referred to herein as the "Retzlaff Trust Parcel" and which is legally described in the attached Exhibit A and illustrated in the attached Exhibit B; and
- 2. Which petition was executed by Bradley M. Retzlaff, as Trustee of the Bradley M. Retzlaff Revocable Trust and Jody L. Retzlaff as Trustee of the Jody L. Retzlaff Revocable Trust, the owners of the Retzlaff Trust Parcel; and
- 3. Which petition conforms to the requirements of Paragraph 3. b. 4. of the Joint Resolution;

WHEREAS, the Retzlaff Trust Parcel abuts the city limits of the City of New Ulm;

WHEREAS, any and all other requirements of the Joint Resolution to effectuate the annexation of the Retzlaff Trust Parcel have been fulfilled and the City of New Ulm deems it in the best interest of the City and its residents that such area be annexed and incorporated into the limits of the City of New Ulm;

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the City Planning Commission, the City Council of the City of New Ulm approved a zoning classification of R-1 (Single Family Residence District) for the Retzlaff Trust Parcel described in the attached Exhibit A and illustrated in the attached Exhibit B.

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved, by the City Council of the City of New Ulm as follows:

- 1. That the Retzlaff Trust Parcel is hereby annexed and incorporated into the limits of the City of New Ulm.
- 2. Pursuant to New Ulm City Code Section 9.04, the Retzlaff Trust Parcel, as described in the attached Exhibit A, shall be zoned R-1(Single Family Residence District) for uses pertinent to zoning.
- 3. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.

- 4. That a certified copy of this Resolution shall be filed, along with a copy of the Joint Resolution, with the State of Minnesota, Office of Administrative Hearings, Chief Administrative Law Judge.
- 5. The Office of Administrative Hearings, Chief Administrative Law Judge or its successor agency may review and comment, but shall within thirty (30) days of receipt of this Resolution and copy of the Joint Resolution, order the annexation of the area designated in this Resolution.
- 6. That the City of New Ulm shall remit to Cottonwood Township property taxes as calculated and prescribed in Paragraph 7.c. of the Joint Resolution.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing resolution was duly seconded by Councilor Fischer and, the roll being called, the following vote was recorded:


