transferred the duties of the Director to the Chief Administrative Law Judge; and

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2007, the Chief Administrative Law Judge has reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in accordance with the terms of the joint resolution to the City of New Auburn, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

Parcel A - Existing Municipal Wastewater Treatment System (MWTS). The NE¼ of NW¼ of Section 19, Township 114, Range 28, Sibley County, Minnesota (40 acres)

and

Parcel B - Expansion Municipal Wastewater Treatment System (MWTS). The NW¼ of NE¼ and the W½ of NE¼ of NE¼ of Section 19, Township 114, Range 28, Sibley County, Minnesota (60 acres)

and

Parcel C - Tenth Avenue Street Expansion.

The East 33 feet of the E½ of NE¼ of NE¼ of Section 19, Township 114, Range 28, Sibley County, Minnesota (1 acre); and the East 33 feet of the E½ of SE¼ of NE¼ of Section 19, Township 114, Range 28, Sibley County, Minnesota (1 acre)

and

Parcel D - Frauendienst.

The E½ of NE¼ of NE¼, except the East 33 feet thereof, of Section 19, Township 114, Range 28, Sibley County, Minnesota (19 acres)

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That pursuant to Minn. Stat. 414.036, the Town of

New Auburn will be reimbursed by the City of New Auburn in accordance with the terms

of the Joint Resolution No. 20070417/1-05-07 signed by the City of New Auburn on
