IN THE MATTER OF THE ORDERLY ANNEXATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF LINDSTROM AND THE TOWN OF CHISAGO LAKE PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTES 414	) ) )	ORDER	

WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of Lindstrom and the Town of Chisago Lake; and

WHEREAS, said joint resolution requests that certain property be annexed to the City of Lindstrom pursuant to M.S. 414.0325; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Director of Strategic and Long Range Planning may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation of land pursuant to said subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, Reorganization Order No. 192, effective March 8, 2005, has transferred the duties of the Director to the Chief Administrative Law Judge; and

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2007, the Chief Administrative Law Judge has reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in accordance with the terms of the joint resolution to the City of Lindstrom,

Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

PID 02-00787-00

That part of Government Lot Four (4), Section Twenty-eight (28), Township Thirty-four (34), Range Twenty (20), Chisago County, Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a point on the south line of said Government Lot 4, 160 feet East of the SW corner thereof; thence North 64° East, 730 feet to a point "a"; thence South 26° East, 315 feet, more or less, to the shore line of North Lindstrom Lake, to the point of beginning of the parcel here described; thence North 26° West, 315 feet, more or less, to point "A"; thence South 64° West, 730 feet, to a point on the South line of said Government Lot 4, 160 feet East of the SW corner thereof; thence East, along the south line of said Government Lot 4, to the shore line of the North Lindstrom Lake; thence Northerly and Easterly, along the shore line of said North Lindstrom Lake, to the point of beginning, and there terminating.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That pursuant to Minn. Stat. 414.036, the Town of Chisago Lake will be reimbursed by the City of Lindstrom in accordance with the terms of the Joint Resolution signed by the City of Lindstrom and Chisago Lake Township on March 22, 2007.
