as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

The North Twenty-seven (27) rods of the East Twenty-one (21) rods of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE¹/₄SE¹/₄) of Section Twelve (12), Township One Hundred Twenty-eight (128) North, Range Thirty-two (32) lying and being West of the right-of-way of State Trunk Highway Twenty-eight (28).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That pursuant to the Joint Resolution signed by the City of

Swanville on May 8, 2007 and the Town of Burnhamville on April 24, 2007, no reimbursement

shall be made to the township pursuant to Minn. Stat. 414.036.
