MINNESOTA STATUTES 414)	

WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of Elrosa and Lake George Township; and

WHEREAS, said joint resolution requests that certain property be annexed to the City of Elrosa pursuant to M.S. 414.0325; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Director of Strategic and Long Range Planning may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation of land pursuant to said subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, Reorganization Order No. 192, effective March 8, 2005, has transferred the duties of the Director to the Chief Administrative Law Judge; and

WHEREAS, on January 24, 2008, the Chief Administrative Law Judge has reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in accordance with the terms of the joint resolution to the City of Elrosa, Minnesota, the same as if

it had originally been made a part thereof:

That part of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 9, Township 124 North, Range 34 West, described as follows: Commence at the Northeast corner of the said Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter; thence South along the East line a distance of 600 feet; thence West on a line parallel to the North line of the said Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter a distance of 580 feet; thence North on a line parallel to the East line of the said Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter a distance of 600 feet to the North line of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter; thence East along the said North line a distance of 580 feet to the point of beginning, containing 7.988 acres, more or less, subject to Trunk Highway No. 71 road easements over the Easterly 75 feet thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That pursuant to Minn. Stat. 414.036, Lake George Township will be reimbursed by the City of Elrosa in accordance with the terms of Joint Resolution No. 2007-3 signed by the City on December 11, 2007 and the Township on December 10, 2007.
