WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of New York Mills and Newton Township; and

WHEREAS, said joint resolution requests that certain property be annexed to the

City of New York Mills pursuant to M.S. 414.0325; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Chief Administrative

Law Judge may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation pursuant to

said subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2008, the Chief Administrative Law Judge reviewed and

accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in accordance with the terms of the joint resolution to the City of New York Mills, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

That part of the NW ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 17, Township 135, Range 37 described as follows: Beginning at the Northwest (NW) corner of the NW ¼ of the NW ¼; thence East (E) a distance of 927 feet, thence South (S) a distance of 132 feet, thence West (W) a distance of 300 feet, thence South (S) a distance of 4 feet, thence West (W) a distance of 627 feet, thence North (N) a distance of 136 feet to the point of beginning, consisting of 2.87 aces, more or less. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That pursuant to Joint Resolution No. 05-13-08, signed by the City of New York Mills on May 13, 2008 and Newton Township on April 14, 2008, no reimbursement shall be made to the township pursuant to Minn. Stat. 414.036.
