PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTES 414)

O R D E R

WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the Cities of Norwood and Young America and the Town of Young America and duly accepted by the Minnesota Municipal Board; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the joint resolution was adopted by the Cities of Norwood and Young America and the Town of Young America and duly accepted by the Minnesota Municipal Board; and

WHEREAS, the amendment to the joint resolution indicated their desire that certain property be immediately annexed to the City of Young America pursuant to M.S. 414.0325, Subdivision 1; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 requires that the Minnesota Municipal Board review and comment, but within 30 days approve the annexation of land pursuant to said subdivision; and

WHEREAS, on June 8, 1987, the Minnesota Municipal Board has reviewed and approved the amendment to the joint resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed to the City of Young America, Minnesota, the same as if it had

originally been made a part thereof:


The S.W. Corner of W1/2 SW1/4 of Section 11, T. 115, R 26. Also known as the 25.7 acres in Tract C.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the mill levy of the City of Young America on the property herein ordered annexed shall be increased in substantially equal proportions over a period of three years to equality with the mill levy of the property already within the city.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the effective date of this order is June 8, 1987.
