**FINDINGS OF FACT,
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
AND ORDER**

The joint resolution for orderly annexation submitted by the City of Carver and Dahlgren Township was reviewed for conformity with applicable law. By delegation, the Chief Administrative Law Judge hereby makes and files the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. A joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of Carver and Dahlgren Township pursuant to Minnesota Statutes § 414.0325 and filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings-Municipal Boundary Adjustment Unit.

2. The city resolution adopted and submitted by the City of Carver requests annexation of part of the designated area described as follows:

That part of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 24, Township 115, Range 24, described as follows: Beginning at the Southwest Corner of said Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter; thence North 620 feet along the West line thereof; thence deflecting to the right 112 degrees 59 minutes from the Northerly prolongation of the last described course a distance of 345.15 feet more or less to the center line of the Carver Henderson Road; thence Southwesterly along the center line of said Road 536.33 feet more or less to the South line of said Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter; thence West 81.0 feet more or less to the point of beginning, according to the United States Government Survey thereof, Carver County, Minnesota.

3. Minnesota Statutes § 414.0325, subd. 1(h) states that in certain circumstances the Chief Administrative Law Judge may review and comment, but shall

within 30 days order the annexation pursuant to the terms of a joint resolution for orderly annexation.

4. The joint resolution contains all the information required by Minnesota Statutes § 414.0325, subd. 1(h).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Office of Administrative Hearings has jurisdiction of the within proceeding.


2. An order should be issued by the Chief Administrative Law Judge or authorized designee annexing the area described herein.
