FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, AND ORDER

The joint resolution for orderly annexation submitted by the City of Lindstrom and Chisago Lake Township was reviewed for conformity with applicable law. By delegation, the Chief Administrative Law Judge hereby makes and files the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On December 10, 2013, the Chief Administrative Law Judge or authorized designee reviewed and accepted the joint resolution which was adopted by the City on October 17, 2013, and the Township on October 29, 2013, and duly filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings, Municipal Boundary Adjustment Unit on December 4, 2013.
- 2. The joint resolution requests the designation and immediate annexation of certain property to the City of Lindstrom described as follows:
 - Lot 13, Block 1, Gerurb Beach according to the plat on file and of record in the Office of the County Recorder, Chisago County, Minnesota.
- 3. Minnesota Statutes § 414.0325, subd. 1(h) states that in certain circumstances the Chief Administrative Law Judge may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation pursuant to the terms of a joint resolution for orderly annexation.
 - 4. The joint resolution contains all the information required by Minnesota

Statutes § 414.0325, subd. 1(h), including a provision that the Chief Administrative Law Judge may review and comment but shall order the annexation within 30 days in accordance with the terms of the joint resolution.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Office of Administrative Hearings has duly acquired and now has jurisdiction of the within proceeding.
- 2. An order should be issued by the Chief Administrative Law Judge or authorized designee annexing the area described herein.

ORDER

- 1. The property described in Findings of Fact 2 is annexed to the City of Lindstrom, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof.
- 2. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes § 414.036, Chisago Lake Township will be reimbursed by the City of Lindstrom in accordance with the terms of the joint resolution signed by the City on October 17, 2013, and Township on October 29, 2013.
