# RESOLUTION NO. 202-18

## A RESOLUTION GRANTING ANNEXATION OF THE NEILS PROPERTY INTO THE CITY OF SAUK RAPIDS

**WHEREAS**, a request was received to annex the property legally described in Exhibit A; and

**WHEREAS**, and the City Council and the property owners agree to the annexation.

WHEREAS the Planning Commission recommends the following:

#### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. Richard Neils, Carol Copeland, Kenneth Neils, Mary Ederer, and Judith Quick are the real property owner(s) of the described property.
- 2. Orderly Annexation Agreement (OAA 170) states that if two of the three affected parties agree to the annexation, the annexation shall be approved.
- 3. Industrial zoning is consistent with the comprehensive plan

#### NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SAUK RAPIDS CITY COUNCIL THAT:

- 1. The above Findings of Fact are adopted.
- 2. The request for annexation is hereby approved for the property described in Exhibit A.
- 3. The quantity of land described in Exhibit A to be annexed is approximately 17 acre(s).
- 4. In accord with MSA 414.0325 and the existing Orderly Annexation Agreement between the City of Sauk Rapids and Sauk Rapids Township, Minnesota Municipal Boundary Adjustments is asked to approve the annexation.
- 5. The Department of Administration may review and comment, but shall within 30 days, order the annexation in accordance with the terms of this resolution.
- 6. The City zones the subject property I-1, Industrial.
- 7. Annexation is granted to allow the Neil's property into the City of Sauk Rapids municipal boundaries, on the conditions that:
  - a. The City or HRA and the property owner enter into a contract to purchase the property described in Exhibit A.
