WHEREAS, Certain territory described below has been designated for orderly annexation to the City of Canby is urban in character, or about to become so, and in need of roadway improvements in the immediate future.

1. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CANBY that annexation proceedings pursuant to Minnesota Statute 414.032 Subd. 2 are hereby initiated upon annexation of the following described property:

Property in County of Yellow Medicine, State of Minnesota, described as:

All that part of Section Four (4) and Section Nine (9), Township One Hundred Fourteen (114) North, Range Forty-five (45) West of the 5th P.M. bounded as follows:

On the Northerly (N'ly) side by the Northerly right of way boundary of Yellow Medicine County Highway No. 30;

On the Southerly (S'ly) side by a line measured perpendicular to and distant one hundred feet (100') Southerly of the Southerly boundary of Yellow Medicine County Highway No. 30.

AND ALSO

All that part of Section Eight (8), Section Five (5) and Section Nine (9), Township One Hundred Fourteen (114) North, Range Forty-five (45) West of the 5th P.M. described as:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Section Eight (8); thence North 50 feet, thence West 33 feet more or less to the West line of the Township road as located;

Thence South along the West line of said Township road a distance of 650 feet;

Thence East a distance of 166 feet more or less to the East side of the Township road between said Section Eight (8) and Section Nine (9);

JOINT RESOLUTION FOR  
ORDERLY ANNEXATION

The Township of Norman and the City of Canby hereby jointly agree to the following:

1. That the following described area in Norman Township is subject to orderly annexation pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.0325, and the parties hereto designate this area for orderly annexation:

Property in County of Yellow Medicine, State of Minnesota, described as:

All that part of Section Four (4) and Section Nine (9), Township One Hundred Fourteen (114) North, Range Forty-five (45) West of the 5th P.M. bounded as follows:

On the Northerly (N'ly) side by the Northerly right of way boundary of Yellow Medicine County Highway No. 30;

On the Southerly (S'ly) side by a line measured perpendicular to and distant one hundred feet (100') Southerly of the Southerly boundary of Yellow Medicine County Highway No. 30.

AND ALSO

All that part of Section Eight (8), Section Five (5) and Section Nine (9), Township One Hundred Fourteen (114) North, Range Forty-five (45) West of the 5th P.M. described as:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Section Eight (8); thence North 50 feet, thence West 33 feet more or less to the West line of the Township road as located;

Thence South along the West line of said Township road a distance of 650 feet;

Thence East a distance of 166 feet more or less to the East side of the Township road between said Section Eight (8) and Section Nine (9);

Thence North 450 feet along said East side of said Township road to the North line of said Section Nine (9);

Thence North to the North boundary of Yellow Medicine County Highway No. 30;

Thence West along the North line of said Yellow Medicine County Highway No. 30 a distance of 133 feet more or less;

Thence Southerly to the point of beginning.

Containing approximately 19 acres more or less.

2. That the Township of Norman does, upon passage of this resolution and its adoption by the City Council of the City of Canby, Minnesota, and upon acceptance by the Municipal Board, confer jurisdiction upon the Minnesota Municipal Board over the various provisions contained in this agreement.

3. Certain properties abutting the City of Canby are presently urban or suburban in nature or are about to become so. Further, the City of Canby and Township of Norman desire to provide for reasonable growth patterns in said area and the City of Canby is in the position to regulate such development and the annexation would be in the best interests of the area proposed for annexation. Therefore, these properties would be immediately annexed to the City of Canby. This area is described as follows:

Property in County of Yellow Medicine, State of Minnesota, described as:

All that part of Section Four (4) and Section Nine (9), Township One Hundred Fourteen (114) North, Range Forty-five (45) West of the 5th P.M. bounded as follows:

On the Northerly (N'ly) side by the Northerly right of way boundary of Yellow Medicine County Highway No. 30;

On the Southerly (S'ly) side by a line measured perpendicular to and distant one hundred feet (100') Southerly of the Southerly boundary of Yellow Medicine County Highway No. 30.

AND ALSO

All that part of Section Eight (8), Section Five (5) and Section Nine (9), Township One Hundred Fourteen (114) North, Range Forty-five (45) West of the 5th P.M. described as:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Section Eight (8); thence North 50 feet, thence West 33 feet more or less to the West line of the Township road as located;

Thence South along the West line of said Township road a distance of 650 feet;

Thence East a distance of 166 feet more or less to the East side of the Township road between said Section Eight (8) and Section Nine (9);

Thence North 450 feet along said East side of said Township road to the North line of said Section Nine (9);

Thence North to the North boundary of Yellow Medicine County Highway No. 30;

Thence West along the North line of said Yellow Medicine County Highway No. 30 a distance of 133 feet more or less;

Thence Southerly to the point of beginning.

Containing approximately 19 acres more or less.

4. That the area described herein is in need of orderly annexation and no alternation of the stated boundaries is appropriate.

5. The City of Canby and the Township of Norman have designated said area in need of orderly annexation and provided for conditions of its annexation and that no consideration by the Minnesota Municipal Board is necessary.

6. That the City agrees to investigate the possibility of sharing facilities, equipment, and personnel with the Township to forestall the duplication of facilities and to reduce the overall costs of government in the area.

7. That the effect of annexations on population shall be resolved whenever possible by agreement of parties. If there is failure to reach such agreement, the question shall be resolved by the Minnesota Municipal Board.



8. That planning throughout the orderly annexation area shall be pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.0325 and shall be as determined from time to time by the City of Canby and the Township of Norman.
