AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CROOKSTON)	<u>ORDER</u>
AND THE TOWN OF ANDOVER PURSUANT TO)	
MINNESOTA STATUTES 414.0325)	

WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of Crookston and the Town of Andover and duly accepted by the Minnesota Municipal Board; and

WHEREAS, said joint resolution requested that certain property be annexed to the City of Crookston pursuant to M.S. 414.0325, Subdivision 1; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Minnesota Municipal Board may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation of land pursuant to said subdivision; and

WHEREAS, on August 2nd, 1990, the Minnesota Municipal Board has reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed to the City of Crookston, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:


Government Lot Four (4), the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW1/4NW1/4), Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW1/4SW1/4), and Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW1/4SW1/4) in Section One (1), and the North Thirty-three (33) feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter

(NW1/4NW1/4) in Section Twelve (12), all in Township One Hundred Forty-nine (149) North of Range Forty-seven (47) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Polk County, Minnesota.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the effective date of this order is August 2, 1990.
