AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BIG LAKE )  
AND THE TOWN OF BIG LAKE PURSUANT TO ) ORDER  
MINNESOTA STATUTES 414 )

WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of Big Lake and the Town of Big Lake; and

WHEREAS, a joint resolution was received from the City of Big Lake and the Town of Big Lake indicating their desire that certain property be annexed to the City of Big Lake pursuant to M.S. 414.0325; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Director of Strategic and Long Range Planning may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation pursuant to said subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, Reorganization Order No. 192, effective March 8, 2005, has transferred the duties of the Director to the Chief Administrative Law Judge.

WHEREAS, on November 15, 2007, the Chief Administrative Law Judge reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in accordance with the terms of the joint resolution to the City of Big Lake, Minnesota, the same as

if it had originally been made a part thereof:

Parcel No. 10-127-2105 - Total Acres: Approximately 0.75

That part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 27, Township 33, Range 27 lying North of railroad and West of local road that was formerly Highway 10, Sherburne County, MN.

Parcel No. 10-127-2201 - Total Acres: Approximately 16

The NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 27, Township 33, Range 27 lying North of railroad right-of-way, Sherburne County, MN.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That pursuant to Minn. Stat. 414.036, the Town of Big Lake will be reimbursed by the City of Big Lake in accordance with the terms of Joint Resolution No. 92-03 signed by the City of Big Lake on February 3, 1992 and the Town of Big Lake on February 12, 1992.
