WHEREAS, on September 6, 1996, the Minnesota Municipal Board has reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed to the City of Sartell, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

Lots One (1) and Two (2) of Block One (1) of Kutzman's Addition Plat 3, according to the

plat and survey thereof on file or of record in the office of the County Recorder, Stearns County, Minnesota.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the population of the City of Sartell is increased by 4.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the population of the Town of LeSauk is decreased by

4.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the tax rate of the City of Sartell on the property herein ordered annexed shall be increased in substantially equal proportions over a period of five years to equality with the tax rate of the property already within the city.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the effective date of this order is September 6, 1996.
