AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF RED WING)	<u>ORDER</u>
AND THE TOWN OF HAY CREEK PURSUANT TO)	
MINNESOTA STATUTES 414)	

WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of Red Wing and the Town of Hay Creek; and

WHEREAS, said joint resolution requests that certain property be annexed to the City of Red Wing pursuant to M.S. 414.0325, Subdivision 1; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Minnesota Municipal Board may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation of land pursuant to said subdivision; and

WHEREAS, on June 9, 1994, the Minnesota Municipal Board has reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed to the City of Red Wing, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:


All that part of Section 5 Township 112 North Range 14 West described as follows: That part of the East 1/2 of the Northwest Quarter and the West 1/2 of the Northeast Quarter that lies easterly of the centerline of T.H. No. 58 except that part previously annexed

pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414 under Orderly Annexation OA-316-11 Red Wing ordered by the Minnesota Municipal Board effective September 15, 1993. AND all of L.B. Danielson Addition according to the record plat thereof on file in the Office of the Goodhue County Recorder. AND all that part of the North 830.00 feet of Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter and North 830.00 feet of the East 447.50 feet of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter that lies westerly of the centerline of T.H. No. 58. AND together with all adjacent roadways.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the effective date of this order is June 9, 1994.
