## **RESOLUTION # 96-04-03**

IN THE MATTER OF THE JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHISAGO LAKES AND THE CITY OF CHISAGO CITY DESIGNATING AN UNINCORPORATED AREAS AS IN NEED OF ORDERLY ANNEXATION AND CONFERRING JURISDICTION OVER SAID AREA TO THE MINNESOTA MUNICIPAL BOARD PURSUANT TO MS 414.0325

## JOINT RESOLUTION FOR ORDERLY ANNEXATION

The Township of Chisago Lakes and the City of Chisago City herein jointly agree to the following:

1. That the following described area in Chisago Lake Township is subject to orderly annexation pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.0325, and the parties hereto designate this area for orderly annexation, to wit:

That part of Lot 20, Chisago Villas, Chisago County, Minnesota.

Lot twenty (20) Chisago Villas except that part of Lot Twenty (20) of Chisago Villas described as follows: Commencing at the most Northerly corner of Block 64; thence Southeasterly along the most Easterly line of Block 64, 50 feet; thence Northewesterly, at a right angle, 70 feet to the point of beginning; thence continuing Northwesterly, along the last described course, 15 feet; thence Southeasterly, at a right angle, 10 feet; thence Southwesterly, at a right angle, 15 feet; thence Northwesterly, at a right angle, 16 feet; thence Southwesterly, at a right angle, 16 feet; thence Northwesterly, at a right angle, 16 feet; thence Northwesterly, at a right angle, 16 feet; thence Northwesterly, at a right angle, 10 feet to the point of beginning.

2. The City shall thereafter govern planning and land use control for the parcel and may zone and subdivide the same in accordance with its ordinance.
