WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the
City of St. Joseph and the Town of St. Joseph; and

WHEREAS, a resolution was received from the City of St. Joseph indicating their
desire that certain property be annexed to the City of St. Joseph pursuant to M.S.
414.0325, Subd. 1; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Minnesota
Municipal Board may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the
annexation of land pursuant to said subdivision; and

WHEREAS, on September 11, 1998, the Minnesota Municipal Board has
reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby
annexed to the City of St. Joseph, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been
made a part thereof:


That part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW 1/4 NE
1/4) of Section Eleven (11), Township One Hundred twenty-four (124),
Range twenty-nine (29) West of the Fifth principal meridian, St. Joseph

Township, Stearns County Minnesota, which lies northerly of the northerly right-of-way line of the Burlington Northern Railroad and which lies westerly of a line 706.92 feet west of and measured at a right angle to and parallel to the east line of said Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW 1/4 NE 1/4); subject to easements of record, if any.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the effective date of this order is September 11, 1998.
