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WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of Lindstrom and the Town of Chisago Lake; and

WHEREAS, said joint resolution requests that certain property be annexed to the City of Lindstrom pursuant to M.S. 414.0325, Subd. 1; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Minnesota Municipal Board may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation of land pursuant to said subdivision; and

WHEREAS, on May 7, 1999, the Minnesota Municipal Board has reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed to the City of Lindstrom, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:


All that part of Government Lot One (1), Section Nine (9), Township Thirty-three (33) North, Range Twenty (20) West, Chisago County, Minnesota, lying westerly of the center line of County State Aid Highway No. 25 and lying South of the north 775 feet of said Government Lot One

(1). Subject to County State Aid Highway No. 25 along the easterly line; subject to the township road along the southerly line; and subject to and including any other valid easements, restrictions and reservations.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the effective date of this order is May 7, 1999.
