JOINT RESOLUTION FOR ORDERLY ANNEXATION

The Township of Great Bend, Lakeside and the City of Windom hereby jointly agree to the following:

1. That the following described area in Great Bend and Lakeside Townships is subject to orderly annexation pursuant to Minnesota Statues 414.0325, and the parties hereto designate this area for orderly annexation, to wit:

LAND DESCRIPTION:

PART OF THE WEST HALF OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 105 NORTH, RANGE 35 WEST IN LAKESIDE TOWNSHIP; AND PART OF THE EAST HALF OF SECTION 24, TOWNSHIP 105 NORTH, RANGE 36 WEST IN GREAT BEND TOWNSHIP, ALL IN COTTONWOOD COUNTY, MINNESOTA, MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

- That the Town Boards of the Townships of Great Bend, Lakeside and the City Council of the City of Windom, upon passage and adoption of this resolution and upon the accep tance by the Minnesota Planning Agency, confer jurisdiction upon the Minnesota Planning Agency over the various provisions contained in the Agreement.
- 3. That these certain properties which abut the City of Windom are presently urban or suburban in nature or are about to become so. Further, the City of Windom is capable of providing services to this area within a reasonable time, and the annexation is in the best interest of the area proposed for annexation. Therefore, these properties would be immediately annexed to the City of Windom, to wit:
- 4. Upon annexation, the City intends to zone the area as I-2
- 5. The Towns of Great Bend, Lakeside and the City of Windom agree that no alteration of the stated boundaries of this agreement is appropriate. Furthermore, each party agrees that no consideration by the Minnesota Planning Agency is necessary. Upon receipt of this resolution, passed and adopted by each party, the Minnesota Planning Agency may review and comment, but shall, within thirty(30) days, order the annexation in accordance with the terms of this joint resolution.
