ORDER

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WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of  
Montrose and the Town of Marysville; and

WHEREAS, said joint resolution requests that certain property be annexed to  
the City of Montrose pursuant to M.S. 414.0325, Subd. 1; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325, M.S. 414.11, and M.S. 414.12 states that in certain  
circumstances the Director of the Office of Strategic and Long Range Planning may  
review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation of land pursuant to  
said subdivision; and

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2000, the Director of the Office of Strategic and Long  
Range Planning has reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby  
annexed to the City of Montrose, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been  
made a part thereof:

The South 695.82 feet of the East 3/8 of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest  
Quarter of Section 35, Township 119, Range 26, Wright County, Minnesota, said

South 695.82 feet is measured at a right angle to the South line of said Southwest Quarter, excepting therefrom the Railroad right of way. Containing approximately 8 acres.

AND

The East Half of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (E1/2 of NW1/4 of SW1/4); and the West Five Eighths of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (W5/8 of SE1/4 of NW1/4); and the West Five Eighths of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (W5/8 of NE1/4 of SW1/4); all in Section Thirty-five (35), Township One Hundred Nineteen (119), Range Twenty-six (26), Wright County, Minnesota. Containing approximately 70 acres.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the effective date of this order is June 9, 2000.
