IN THE MATTER OF THE JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF BECKER AND THE CITY OF BECKER DESIGNATING UNINCORPORATED AREAS AS IN NEED OF ORDERLY ANNEXATION AND CONFERRING JURISDICTION OVER SAID AREAS TO MINNESOTA PLANNING PURSUANT TO M.S. 414.0325

The Township of Becker and City of Becker hereby jointly agree to the following:

1. That the following described areas in Becker Township are subject to orderly annexation pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.0325, and the parties hereto designate this area for orderly annexation:

The West 371.28 feet of the North 586.62 feet of the North ½ of the Southwest ¼ of Section 19, Township 34, Range 28.

2. That the Township of Becker does, upon passage of this resolution and its adoption by the City Council of the City of Becker, Minnesota, and upon acceptance by Minnesota Planning, confer jurisdiction upon Minnesota Planning, over the various provisions contained in this agreement.
3. That this property which abuts the City of Becker is presently urban or suburban in nature or are about to become so. Further, the City of Becker is capable of providing services to this area within a reasonable time, and the annexation would be in the best interest of the area proposed for annexation. Therefore, the aforementioned property will be immediately annexed to the City of Becker. The area is described as follows:

The West 371.28 feet of the North 586.62 feet of the North ½ of the Southwest ¼ of Section 19, Township 34, Range 28.

4. Within the orderly annexation area, the parties agree to reimbursement of property taxes lost to the Township as a result of the annexation. The reimbursement shall be made according to the following: For each of the five years the City shall make payments based on the Township's portion of the taxes paid on the parcel of property in the year 2001. The first year shall be 90 percent. The second year shall be 70 percent. The third year shall be 50 percent. The fourth year shall be 30 percent. In the final year the reimbursement shall be 10 percent.

At the City's discretion it may make one payment equal to the total of the five annual payments.

5. Both the Town of Becker and the City of Becker agree that no alteration of the stated boundaries of this agreement is appropriate. Furthermore, each party agrees that no consideration by Minnesota Planning is necessary. Upon receipt of this resolution, passed and adopted by each party, Minnesota Planning may review and comment, but shall, within thirty (30) days, order the annexation in accordance with the terms of this joint resolution.

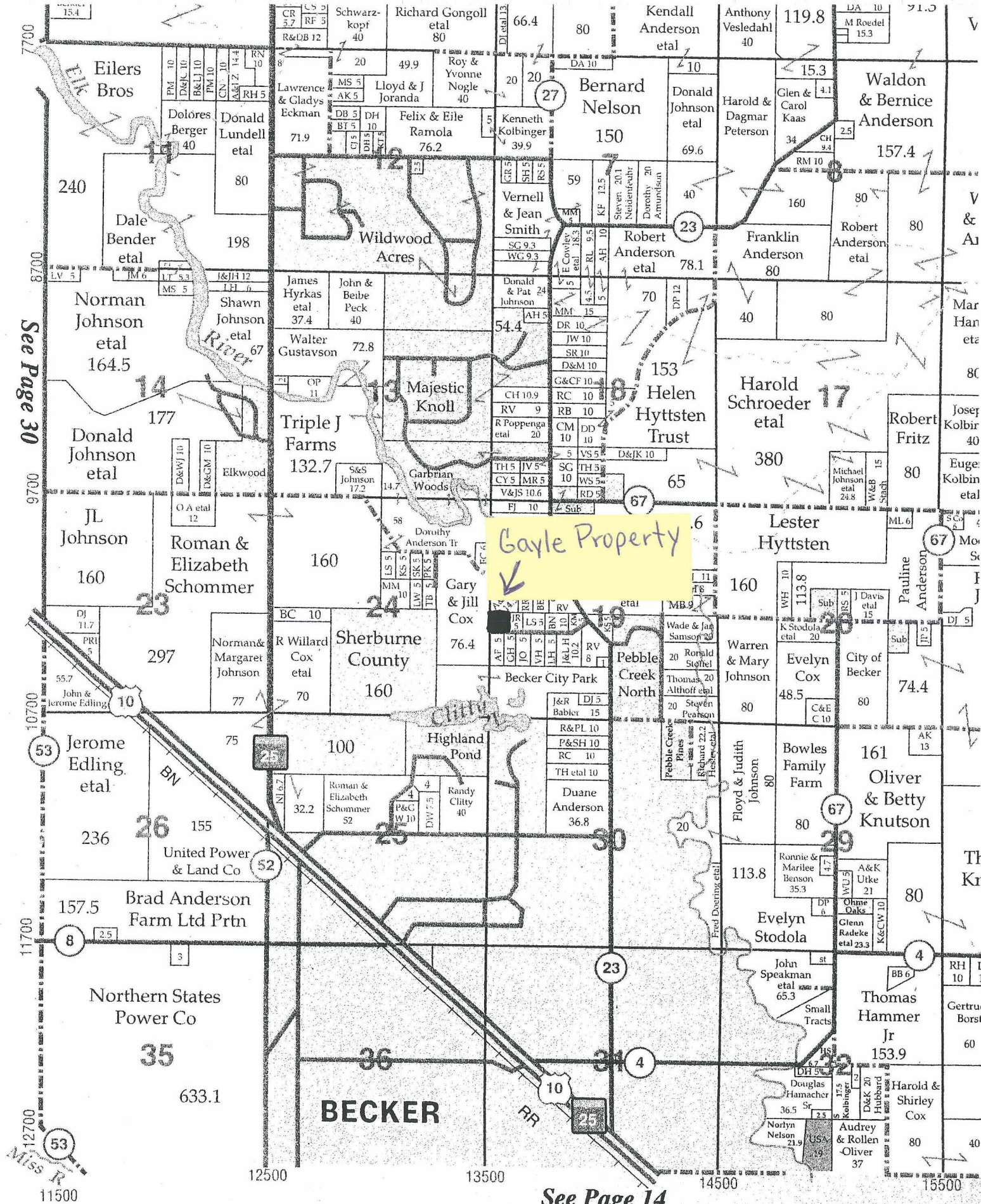

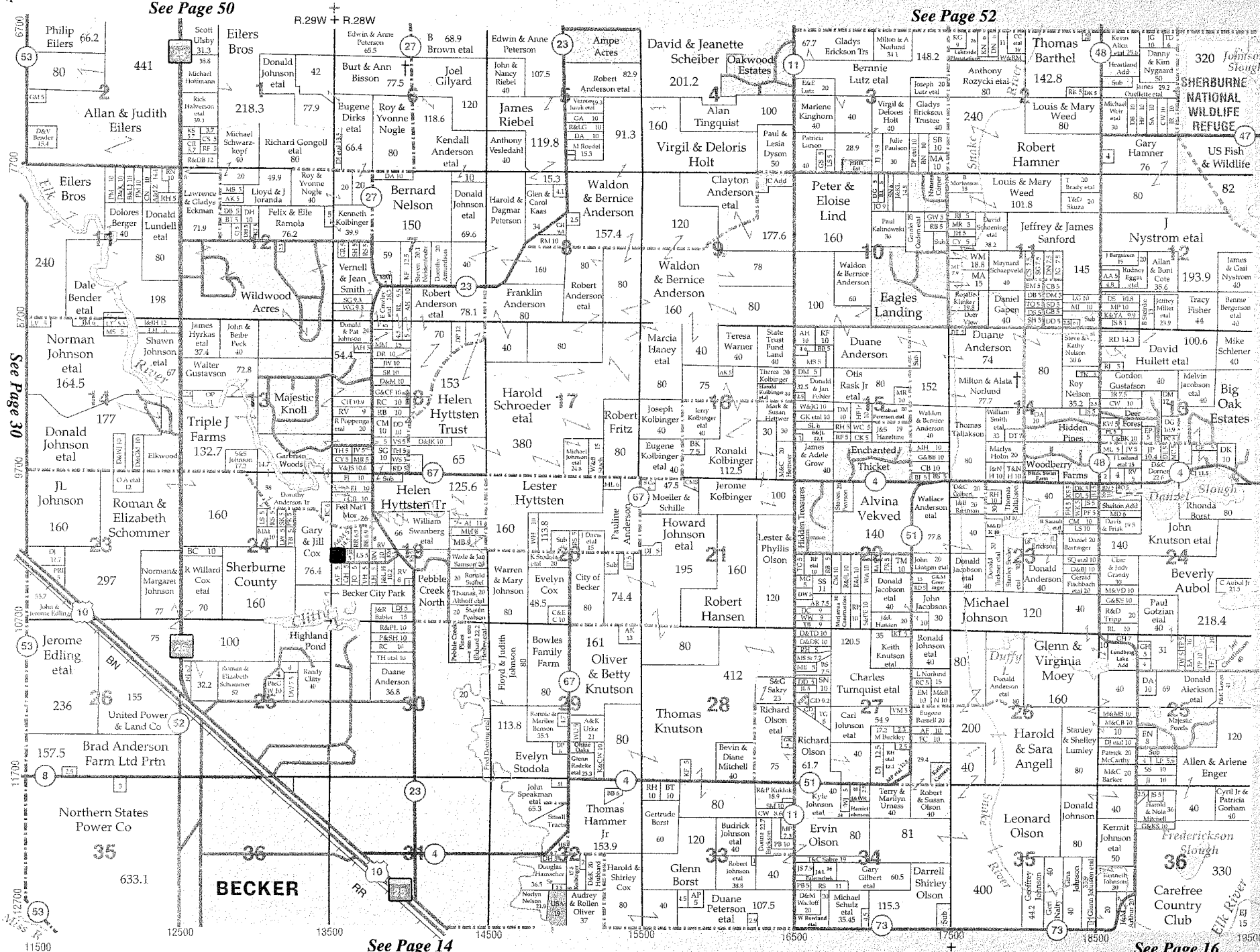
