IN THE MATTER OF THE JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF HERSEY AND THE CITY OF BREWSTER, NOBLES COUNTY, MINNESOTA, DESIGNATING AN UNINCORPORATED AREA AS IN NEED OF ORDERLY ANNEXATION AND CONFERRING JURISDICTION OVER SAID AREA TO THE MINNESOTA MUNICIPAL BOARD PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTE §414.0325.

JOINT RESOLUTION FOR ORDERLY ANNEXATION

The Township of Hersey and the City of Brewster, all in Nobles County, Minnesota,

hereby jointly agree to the following:

1. That the following described area in the Township of Hersey is subject to orderly

annexation pursuant to Minnesota Statutes §414.0325, and the parties hereto designate this area

for orderly annexation, to wit:

Part of the Southeast Quarter (SE1/4) of Section 24, Township 103, Range 39, described as follows: Beginning at a point where the south right of way line of the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad intersects with the East boundary line of said SE1/4, thence southeasterly along said railroad right of way line a distance of 1350 feet; thence perpendicular to said right of way line a distance of 450 feet; thence due east on a line perpendicular to the east boundary line of said SE 1/4 a distance of 670 feet to the east line of said SE 1/4; thence north along the east boundary line of said SE1/4 a distance of 1200 feet more or less to the point of beginning.

2. That the Town Board of the Township of Hersey and the City Council of the City of

Brewster, upon passage and adoption of this resolution and upon the acceptance by the Municipal

Board, confer jurisdiction upon the Municipal Board over the various provisions contained in this

Agreement.

3. That this certain property abuts the City of Brewster, and will become urban in nature.

Further, the City of Brewster is capable of providing services to this area within a reasonable

time, and the annexation is in the best interest of the area proposed for annexation. Therefore

this property would be immediately annexed to the City of Brewster, to wit:

Part of the Southeast Quarter (SE1/4) of Section 24, Township 103, Range 39, described as follows: Beginning at a point where the south right of way line of the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad intersects with the East boundary line of said SE1/4, thence southeasterly along said railroad right of way line a distance of 1350 feet; thence perpendicular to said right of way line a distance of 450 feet; thence due east on a line perpendicular to the east boundary line of said SE 1/4 a distance of 670 feet to the east line of said SE 1/4; thence north along the east boundary line of said SE1/4 a distance of 1200 feet more or less to the point of beginning.

4. The City shall zone the aforesaid property as commercial/industrial.

5. Both the Township of Hersey and the City of Brewster agree no alteration of the

stated boundaries of this agreement is appropriate. Furthermore, each party agrees that no consideration by the Municipal Board is necessary. Upon receipt of this resolution, passed and adopted by each party, the Municipal Board may review an comment, but shall, within thirty (30) days, order the annexation in accordance with the terms of this joint resolution.
