WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of Albany and the Town of Albany; and

WHEREAS, said joint resolution requests that certain property be annexed to the City of Albany pursuant to M.S. 414.0325; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Director of the Office of Strategic and Long Range Planning may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order the annexation of land pursuant to said subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, on November 8, 2002, the Acting Director of the Office of Strategic and Long Range Planning has reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in accordance with the terms of the joint resolution to the City of Albany, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

That part of NE ¼ of the NE ¼ of Section 22, Township 125 North, Range 31 West, described as follows: Beginning at the southeast corner of said NE ¼ of the NE ¼;

thence go westerly along the south line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ to the easterly right of way of Old Highway No. 52; thence go northwesterly along said right of way 330.00 feet; thence easterly to a point on the east line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ a distance of 393.00 feet north of the point of beginning; thence southerly along the east line of said 40 acre tract aforesaid a distance of 393 feet to the point of beginning and there terminating, according to the plat and survey thereof on file and of record in and for Stearns County, Minnesota.
