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WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the City of Little Falls and the Town of Belle Prairie; and

WHEREAS, said joint resolution requests that certain property be annexed to the City of

Little Falls pursuant to M.S. 414.0325; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 states that in certain circumstances the Director of the Office

of Strategic and Long Range Planning may review and comment, but shall within 30 days order

the annexation of land pursuant to said subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, on February 25, 2003, the Acting Director of the Office of Strategic and

Long Range Planning has reviewed and accepted the resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed in accordance with the terms of the joint resolution to the City of Little Falls, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

Parcel No. 1 – Riverwood Drive: All that part of County Road 260, also known as Riverwood Drive, not previously annexed, lying northerly of the U.S. Highway 10, as shown on State Highway Right of Way Plat No. 1 of 6, State Project 4902 (10=37) 901, northerly to its intersection with the westerly right of way line of State Highway 371, all located in Sections 14, 23, 26 and 27, all in Township 41 North, Range 32 West; AND Parcel No. 2 – Mississippi Boulevard: All that part of Mississippi Boulevard shown in the Plat of The First Addition to Oak Ridge, filed in the Morrison County Recorder's Office, lying northerly and northeasterly of the northwesterly extension of the southwesterly line of Lot 4. All being approximately 21.65 acres, more or less.
