JOINT RESOLUTION FOR ORDERLY ANNEXATION

IN THE MATTER OF THE JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NEW LONDON AND THE CITY OF NEW LONDON DESIGNATING AN UNINCORPORATED AREA AS IN NEED OF ORDERLY ANNEXATION AND CONFERRING JURISDICTION OVER SAID AREA TO MINNESOTA PLANNING PURSUANT TO 414.0325.

The Township of New London and the City of New London hereby agree to the following:

1. That the following described area in New London Township is subject to orderly annexation pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.0325, and the parties hereto designate this area for orderly annexation:

The NE ¼ of the NE ¼ of Section 9, Township 121, Range 34, Kandiyohi County, Minnesota. Containing 39.60 acres, more or less.

- 2. That the Township of New London does, upon passage of this resolution and its adoption by the City Council of the City of New London, Minnesota, and upon acceptance by Minnesota Planning, confer jurisdiction upon Minnesota Planning over the various provisions contained in this agreement. No consideration by Minnesota Planning is necessary, Minnesota Planning may review and comment, but shall, within 30 days, order the annexation in accordance with the terms of the resolution.
- 3. Certain properties abutting the City of New London are presently residential in nature or are about to become so. Further, the City of New London is capable of providing services to this area within a reasonable time.
