ORDINANCE NUMBER 2007-02

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ANNEXATION OF LAND TO THE CITY OF CLARKS GROVE

The City Council of Clarks Grove, Minnesota, ordains:

SECTION I: The following legally described area of land is hereby annexed to the City of Clarks Grove:

Parcel A:

All that part of the $N\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 3 T103N-R21 W, Freeborn County, Minnesota described as follows:

Commencing at the northeast corner of Lot 1, Block A of the Village of Clarks Grove, as the same is platted and recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Freeborn County, Minnesota; thence West a distance of 566.15 feet, on the north line of said Lot 1, Block a and a westerly extension thereof; thence Southwesterly a distance of 1766.88 feet, at a deflection angle of 82°38'30" left, on a line parallel with and 50.00 feet west of the centerline of the main track of the Union Pacific Railroad (formerly the Chicago, Rock Island & Pacific Railroad); thence West a distance of 25.21 feet, at a deflection angle of 82°42'00" right; thence Southwesterly a distance of 576.00 feet, at a deflection angle of 82°42'00" left; thence West a distance of 125.00 feet, at a deflection angle of 90°00'00" right; thence Northeasterly a distance of 376.00 feet, at a deflection angle of 90°00'00" right, to the point of beginning;

thence West a distance of 944.23 feet, at a deflection angle of 96 ol 4'46" left;

thence North a distance of 635.73 feet, at a deflection angle of $89 \circ 06'05''$ right, to a point on the north line of the NE¼ of said Section 3;

thence East a distance of 1025.87 feet, at a deflection angle of $89 \circ 54'11''$ right, on the north line of said $NE\frac{1}{4}$, to a point on a line drawn parallel with and 200 feet westerly (measured at a right angle) from the centerline of said Union Pacific Railroad main track;

thence Southwesterly a distance of 657.38 feet, at a deflection angle of 97°14'29" right, on a line drawn parallel with and 200 feet westerly (measured at a right angle) from the centerline of said Union Pacific Railroad main track, to the point of beginning, containing 14.57 acres ±. Parcel B

All that part of the $NE^{1/4}$ $NE^{1/4}$ Section 3-T103N-R21 W, Freeborn County, Minnesota; described as follows:

Commencing at the northeast corner of Lot 1, Block A of the Village of Clarks Grove, Minnesota, as the same is platted and recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Freeborn County, Minnesota; thence West a distance of 566.15 feet, on the north line of said Lot 1, Block A and a westerly extension thereof; thence Southwesterly a distance of 1766.88 feet, at a deflection angle of 82°38'30" left, on a line parallel with and 50.00 feet west of the centerline of the main track of the Union Pacific Railroad (formerly the Chicago, Rock Island & Pacific Railroad); thence West a distance of 25.21 feet, at a deflection angle of 82°42'00" left, to the point of beginning;

thence continuing Southwesterly a distance of 16.00 feet, on a southerly extension of the last described line;

thence West a distance of 125.00 feet, at a deflection angle of 90 00'00" right;

thence Northeasterly a distance of 376.00 feet, at a deflection angle of 90 00'00" right;

thence West a distance of 535.56 feet, at a deflection angle of 96 014'46" left;

thence South a distance of 320.64 feet, at a deflection angle of 90 o7'30" left;

thence East a distance of 471.28 feet, at a deflection angle of 89°52′30″ left;

thence Southwesterly a distance of 79.74 feet, at a deflection angle of 96 ol 4'46" right;

thence East a distance of 179.39 feet, at a deflection angle of 96°14'46" left to a point on a line drawn parallel with and 50 feet westerly (measured at a right angle) from the centerline of said

Union Pacific Railroad main track;

thence Northeasterly a distance of 25.88 feet, at a deflection angle of 83 °45'14" left along the said line drawn parallel with and 50 feet westerly (measured at a right angle) from the centerline of said Union Pacific Railroad main track;

thence Northwesterly a distance of 25.00 feet, at a deflection angle of 90 o00'00" left, to the point of beginning.

Less the following described tract:

Commencing at the intersection of the west line of said Union Pacific Railroad and the south line of said $NE\frac{1}{4}$ $NE\frac{1}{4}$;

thence Northeasterly a distance of 290.00 feet, on the west line of said Union Pacific Railroad; thence West a distance of 20.00 feet;

thence Southwesterly a distance of 292.46 feet, to a point on the south line of said $NE^{1/4}$ $NE^{1/4}$; thence East a distance of 20.15 feet, on the south line of said $NE^{1/4}$ $NE^{1/4}$, to the point of beginning.

SECTION II: THE TOWNSHIP OF BANCROFT HAVING ASSENTED TO THE

ANNEXATION and the Notice of Public Hearing thereon having been posted and said hearing held as required by law, the annexation by Ordinance is completed.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon it's passage and upon publication in the official newspaper of the city.
