WAIVER OF OBJECTION

That part of Lot D of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 29, Township 110 North, Range 32 West, Brown County, Minnesota described as follows:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Lot 4, Block Three, Fairhill Second Addition; thence North 89 degrees 47 minutes 07 seconds West, bearings based on Brown County Coordinate System NAD83(11) on the north line of said Fairhill Second Addition, a distance of 33.41 feet to the west line of said Lot D; thence North 00 degrees 02 minutes 32 seconds West, on said west line, a distance of 198.69 feet; thence South 89 degrees 53 minutes 46 seconds East, a distance of 33.41 feet; thence South 00 degrees 02 minutes 32 seconds East, a distance of 198.76 feet to the point of beginning. Parcel contains 0.15 acres of land (hereinafter "Property").
