

At a second regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Crookston held on the 23rd day of May 2022, Council

Member Donald Cavalier offered the following resolution which was seconded by Council

RESOLUTION FOR DETACHMENT OF PROPERTY FROM THE CITY PARCEL 82.00077.03

WHEREAS, the Biermaier Family Limited Liability Partnership is the owner of real property located in the City of Crookston legally described as Government Lot 10 Section 31 Township 150 North Range 46 and west of the 5th principal meridian which is designated as parcel 82.00077.03 and

WHEREAS, the real property designated as parcel number 82.00077.03 abuts the municipal boundaries of the City of Crookston "Exhibit A" and,

WHEREAS, the Biermaier Family Limited Liability Partnership has filed a petition for detachment from the City of Crookston 'Exhibit B' and,

WHEREAS, the real property designated as parcel number 82.00077.03 is rural in character, is not developed for urban residential, commercial, or industrial purposes and

WHEREAS, the real property designated as parcel number 82.00077.03 has a area of less than 40 acres more specifically 27.25 acres and,

WHEREAS, the real property designated as parcel number 82.00077.03 has no buildings, no residents and no municipal improvements and,

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Minnesota Statute § 414.06 the petition for detachment has been commenced by 100% of the property owner of parcels number 82.00077.03 all twelve members Biermaier Family Limited Liability Partnership and,

WHEREAS, the city of Crookston ordinances and codes restrict and limit the use of the real property designated as parcel number 82.00077.03 with respect to hunting, trapping, forestry and recreational.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CROOKSTON, MINNESOTA:

That the City of Crookston supports the petition for detachment as presented by the Biermaier Family Limited Liability Partnership and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED the Mayor and City Administrator for the City of Crookston are authorized to sign all documents and amendments thereto necessary to support the petition for detachment for the Biermaier Family Limited Liability Partnership of lands within the City of Crookston pursuant to Minnesota Statute § 414.06.


