RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CURRIE CONCERNING DETACHMENT OF CERTAIN LAND PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTES § 414.06

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CURRIE, COUNTY OF MURRAY, MINNESOTA AS FOLLOWS:

The City of Currie received a petition for detachment of certain property on October 11, 2022; from Phil Gervais for the property described on the attached exhibit A.

Mr. Gervais owns the property in its entirety. The City of Currie does not to oppose the petition for detachment. There are no municipal improvements or buildings located on the described property and there are no persons currently living on the exhibit A property.

It is impractical for the City of Currie to provide city services, including sewer, water or street services, to the property described on Exhibit A. The described property is unlikely to become urban or suburban in character in the foreseeable future.

MOTION FOR ADOPTION of the foregoing resolution was made by Larson, seconded by Olivier, and upon vote being taken all members voted in favor thereof and the resolution was declared passed and adopted.

The West 700 Feet of the East Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 17, Township 107 North, Range 40 West of the 5th Principal Meridian, Murray County, Minnesota, lying North of the centerline of County State Aid Highway 51 and Northeasterly of the northeasterly right of way of Minnesota Trunk Highway number 30.
