IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the objection of the Town of Buffalo to the annexation of the following described land to the Village of Buffalo be dismissed:

> Commencing at the center of Section 19, Township 120, Range 25; thence South on the Quarter line 451.4 feet to the point of beginning; thence continue South on the Quarter line 710 feet more or less to the right-of way line of Trunk Highway #55; thence Northwesterly along said Trunk Highway #55 right-of-way line 500 feet; thence deflect 90° right 235 feet; thence continue in a Northeasterly direction to the point of beginning, containing 2.46 acres more or less.
