IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is hereby annexed to the City of New Prague, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof:

All that part of section 33, in Township 113 North, Range 23 West, Scott County, Minnesota described as follows:

Commencing 95 rods North from the Southeast corner of Section 33 in Township 113 North, Range 23 West, Thence

running West 160 rods, thence North 40 rods, thence East 160 rods, thence South 40 rods to the place of commencement; except the East 767 feet.
