PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTES 414)

O R D E R

WHEREAS, a joint resolution for orderly annexation was adopted by the
Cities of Norwood and Young America and the Town of Young America and duly
accepted by the Minnesota Municipal Board; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the joint resolution was adopted by the
Cities of Norwood and Young America and the Town of Young America and duly
accepted by the Minnesota Municipal Board; and

WHEREAS, the amendment to the joint resolution indicated their desire
that certain property be immediately annexed to the City of Norwood pursuant
to M.S. 414.0325, Subdivision 1; and

WHEREAS, M.S. 414.0325 requires that the Minnesota Municipal Board
review and comment, but within 30 days approve the annexation of land pursuant
to said subdivision; and

WHEREAS, on June 12, 1986, the Minnesota Municipal Board has reviewed
and approved the amendment to the joint resolution for orderly annexation;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the following described property is
hereby annexed to the City of Norwood, Minnesota, the same as if it had
originally been made a part thereof:

Commencing at a point which is 33 feet South, thence 144 feet East of
the Southwest Corner of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of the

Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of Section 14-115-26, thence running South 367.4 feet to a point, thence West 94 feet to a point; thence North 367.4 feet to a point; thence East 94 feet to the point of beginning. Lying and being in the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of said Section 14-115-26.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the effective date of this order is June 12, 1986.
