ORDINANCE NO. 205

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SLAYTON, MURRAY COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY BORDERED BY LAND WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS AND ABUTTING THEREON.

WHEREAS, certain territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, or borough; and

WHEREAS, this territory is forty (40) acres or less in area and sixty per cent (60%) or more of the perimeter of the territory is bordered by lands already included within the corporate limits of the City of Slayton; and

WHEREAS, this territory is deemed to be urban or suburban in character; and

WHEREAS, proper notice has been given by the City of Slayton of its intent to annex and no objections to the annexation have been received or filed; and

WHEREAS, the time period for the filing of objections has now expired;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SLAYTON, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the City of Slayton, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the unplatted territory described as follows, sixty per cent (60%) or more of the perimeter of which territory is bordered by territory already included within the City limits:


A tract of land in the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 10, Township 106, Range 41, (Slayton Township), described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the West right of way line of Trunk Highway No. 59, 1153.05 feet South of the North line of said Northwest Quarter of Section 10, Township 106, Range 41; thence West at right angle a distance of 458.5 feet; thence South at right angle a distance of 190 feet; thence East at right angle a distance of 458.5 feet; thence North at right angle a distance of 190 feet to the point of beginning, consisting of 2 acres, be it more or less.

Section 2. Filing. The City Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Secretary of State, the Murray County Auditor and the Town Clerk of Slayton Township and the Minnesota Municipal Board.

Section 3. Effective Date of Annexation. This Ordinance takes effect upon passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2 and approved by the Minnesota Municipal Board.


