Ordinance No. 92

An ordinance annexing certain territory to the City of Spring Grove.

The City Council of the City of Spring Grove ordains:

That Whereas, a petition has been duly filed with the City Clerk requesting the annexation to the City of Spring Grove of certain territory therein and hereinafter described, and whereas a hearing has been held on the 2nd day of January, A. D. 1985, at 7:30 P. M. in the City Hall in the City of Spring Grove, to consider the proposed annexation and any arguments for and against the same, and whereas the council has found that the petition was in proper form and duly signed by a majority of the owners of the land described, and that 30 days' posted notice of the said hearing was given as provided by law,


And Whereas, the council at said hearing has found that the land described herein and in said petition is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to City government, and has determined that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City and of the territory affected,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Spring Grove, Houston County, Minnesota, does hereby ordain and declare annexed to said City of Spring Grove, the following described territory:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of Lot 58 in Second Church Addition to Spring Grove according to the recorded plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the County Recorder in and for Houston County, Minnesota, thence East 485 feet to the Southeast corner of said Lot 58, thence North along the East line of said Lot 58 a distance of 75 feet, thence East to the West line of Lot 65 of Second Church Addition, thence continue East a distance of 190 feet, thence South a distance of 75 feet, thence South 28 degrees 30' East a distance of 54 feet, thence West a distance of 20 feet to the Northeast corner of Lot 11 of Second Church Addition, thence West along the Southerly boundary line of Nelson Street to the point of beginning.
