A Petition for Annexation, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.033 subdivision 5 was filed and received by the City Council on March 12, 1984. Said Petition affects the following described property:

Commencing at the southeast corner of Block 8, Zieger's Subdivision, in the City of New Richland, as the same is platted and recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Waseca County, Minnesota;
