## ORDINANCE NO. 125, 2ND SERIES

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ST. PETER TO INCLUDE ONE ACRE MORE OR LESS OF DODD ROAD LOCATED IN SECTION 8, TOWNSHIP 110 NORTH, RANGE 26 WEST, NICOLLET COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. PETER ORDAINS:

Section 1. The following tract of land, consisting of a part of Dodd Road, unincorporated and unplatted, abutting on the City of St. Peter, owned by the City of St. Peter, is hereby declared by the City Council to be annexed to the City and pursuant to Minn. Stats. 414.033, said land is deemed to be urban in character. The tract of land consisting of one acre more or less is described as follows:

All that part of the North 33 feet of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 lying easterly of the centerline of M.T.H. #22 all in Section 8 -Township 110 N - Range 26 W, Nicollet County, Minnesota.

Section 2. The annexation will be to the best interests to the City of St. Peter.

Section 3. The corporate limits of the City of St. Peter are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1, and the same is hereby annexed and included within the City as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 4. All the provisions of Chapter 1 of the St. Peter City Code are made a part hereof and applicable to this Ordinance.

Section 5. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the Secretary of State, the Nicollet County Auditor and the Traverse Township Clerk.
