Councilmember Akre introduced the following ordinance and moved for its adoption:

ORDINANCE NO. 88-7-17

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS
OF THE CITY OF GRAND RAPIDS, MINNESOTA
TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PROPERTY
ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, certain territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borough; and

WHEREAS, this territory is surrounded on three sides by lands already included within the corporate limits of the city, and

WHEREAS, Itasca County and Grand Rapids Township have notified the City that they have no objections to this annexation, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has notified property owners affected by this annexation that the City Council was considering adopting an ordinance to annex certain properties described below on July 13, 1988, and

WHEREAS, there was no one present at this meeting to voice their objections to the annexation.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Grand Rapids ordains:

Section 1. Territory annexed. The corporate limits of the City of Grand Rapids, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the unplatted territory as follows: SW 1/4 - SW 1/4 less E495' and less SW 1/4 SW1/4 SW1/4 SW1/4, Section 15, Township 55, Range 25.

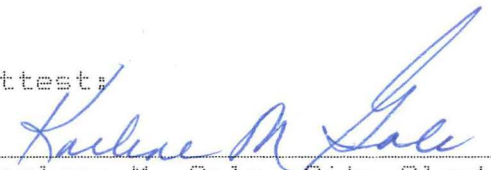
Section 2. Filing. The City Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of Itasca County, Grand Rapids Township Board, and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

Section 3. Effective Date of Annexation. this ordinance takes effect upon passage and publication, the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2, and notification by the Minnesota Municipal Commission.
