

ORDINANCE NO. 181, 2ND SERIES

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SAINT PETER TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PROPERTY OWNED BY AND ABUTTING UPON THE LIMITS OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the territory described below is not presently within the corporate limits of any incorporated City; and

WHEREAS, this territory abuts upon the corporate limits of the City at the northern boundary thereof and is deemed to be urban or suburban in character; and

WHEREAS, this territory is currently owned by Nicollet County; and

WHEREAS, the City and Nicollet County have an agreement by which the City agrees to annex this territory; and

WHEREAS, this territory may be annexed by ordinance pursuant to M.S. 414.033 when the City takes ownership of the territory; and

WHEREAS, the Nicollet County Board meets on September 12, 1989, and has on its agenda the disposition of this property; and

WHEREAS, the City expects that Nicollet County will Quit Claim its interest in this territory to the City at its September 12th meeting so that the City will own the property in fee; and

WHEREAS, present action must be taken to meet highway construction deadlines;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAINT PETER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Territory annexed. The Corporate limits of the City of Saint Peter are hereby extended to include the property described as follows upon its transfer to the City:


That portion of Minnesota Avenue (Third Street) right-of-way in plats, Traverse Des Sioux north of Sibley and Traverse Des Sioux south of Sibley, beginning at a point on the north corporate limits of the City of Saint Peter at its junction with Minnesota Avenue; thence northeasterly through the northeast quarter of Section 9, Township 100 North, Range 26 West to the westerly line of the Highway right-of-way of U.S. Highway Number 169 and there terminating containing 2.8 acres more or less.


Section 2. Filing. The City Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of the county in which the property is located, the Town Clerk of the affected township and the Minnesota Municipal Board.

Section 3. Applicability. All the provision of Chapter 1 of the Saint Peter City Code are made a part hereof and applicable to this Ordinance.

Section 4. Effective date of annexation. This ordinance takes effect upon transfer of the property to the City, passage and publication of the ordinance, and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2, and approval by the Minnesota Municipal Board.
