The area proposed for annexation is described as follows:

That part of Government Lot 2, Government Lot 3, Government Lot 4  
and the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter, all in Section 34,  
Township 119, Range 27, Wright County Minnesota, Described as follows:

Commencing at the southeast corner of said Government Lot 2; thence  
northerly, along the east line of said Government Lot 2, Government Lot 3, and  
the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter, to the northeast corner of  
said Section 34; thence westerly, along the north line of said Section 34, to  
the intersection with the centerline of Ingram Ave. (T-402) as described in  
Document No. 409445; thence southerly and southwesterly, along said  
centerline to the intersection with the northeasterly right of way line of  
Imhoff Ave. (T-817) as described in Document No. 409445; thence northwesterly,  
along said northeasterly right of way line, to the intersection with the  
northerly extension of the east line of BRIARWOOD, according to the recorded  
plat thereof; thence southerly along the east line of said BRIARWOOD and it's  
northerly extension, to the waters edge of Howard Lake; thence southeasterly,  
southerly and southwesterly, along said waters edge, to the intersection with  
the south line of Government Lot 2; thence easterly, along said south line to  
the point of beginning.

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
