

PETITION FOR ANNEXATION

TO THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DILWORTH, MINNESOTA:

Donald Kroshus, the owner of the land described below, hereby requests the Council to annex this land to the City and to extend the City boundaries to include the same, and for the purpose respectfully states as follows:

1. That the land to be annexed consists entirely of unplatted land. That said land lies in Moorhead Township, Clay County, Minnesota. That the land proposed to be annexed to the City of Dilworth consists of 80.00 acres, more or less, and is described as follows:

The North Half of the Southeast Quarter (N1/2SE1/4) of Section Three (3), Township One Hundred Thirty-nine (139N), Range Forty-eight West (48W) of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Clay County, Minnesota. Said tract abuts the existing westerly City Limits boundary.

2. The land described above lies immediately north of Clay County Ditch No. 50 and the easterly boundary of said tract abuts the westerly boundary of the City, and none of said land is presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated City or Burrough.
3. All of this land is or is about to become urban or suburban in character.
4. That if the land is annexed to the City of Dilworth and at such time as it is platted, it is intended to refer to this land as _____ to the City of Dilworth, Clay County, Minnesota.
5. That attached to this petition is a map designating the land to which this petition applies.

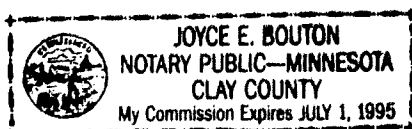
