RESOLUTION OF TOWN BOARD OF HOME TOWNSHIP, STATE OF MINNESOTA

The following Resolution was adopted by the Township Board of Home Township, Minnesota, at its regular meeting held on October 27, 1992.

RESOLVED, that the Township Board of Home Township, Minnesota, consents to the Petition for Annexation of Marilyn Burda and Darwin Burda, dated October 20, 1992, concerning the following described property:


THAT PART OF THE WEST HALF OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 29, TOWNSHIP 110 NORTH, RANGE 32 WEST, BROWN COUNTY, MINNESOTA, described as follows:


Beginning at the Southwest corner of Outlot A of Kroschel's Subdivision in the Northwest Quarter of said Southeast Quarter of Sec. 29; then South 89 degrees 58 minutes 48 seconds East, an assumed bearing, along the south line of said Outlot A and the easterly prolongation of said south line 470.00 feet; then South 00 degrees 08 minutes 36 seconds East parallel with the west line of said Southeast Quarter 1385.43 feet to the northerly right-of-way line of the Dakota Minnesota and Eastern Railroad; then South 78 degrees 03 minutes 46 seconds West 480.13 feet to the said west line of the Southeast Quarter of Sec. 29; then North 00 degrees 08 minutes 36 seconds West along said west line 1484.90 feet to the point of beginning containing 15.5 acres, more or less and being subject to easements of record in said county and state.

That Board consents to the annexation based on the fact that the addition will be used for benefits which will serve both the rural and urban area. The area to be annexed is presently bounded on the City, and the area will become urban or suburban in character. The Board acknowledges service of the Annexation Petition upon it and waives its right to the ninety (90) day objection period as set out in MSA Section 414.033, Subdivision 5.
