ORDINANCE NO. 093-299

An Ordinance Annexing Certain Unincorporated Property Abutting the City of Farmington, Consisting of Approximately 13.5 Acres, More or Less

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON, MINNESOTA HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the City of Farmington (the "City") has studied its municipal borders and the City's growth patterns; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to promote orderly growth and provide municipal services in an efficient manner; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Minnesota Statute §414.033, the City received a petition dated January 6, 1993 from Wausau Supply Company for annexation of approximately 13.5 acres of property abutting the City owned by Wausau, which property is currently located in Empire Township and described legally in Exhibit A to the petition (the "property") which petition is attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to proceed with the annexation of said property by ordinance pursuant to Minnesota Statute §414.033; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that (i) the property proposed for annexation is, or is about to become, urban or suburban in character, (ii) annexation of said property and municipal government is required to protect the public health, safety and welfare, and (iii) annexation would be in the best interest of the property proposed for annexation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Farmington as follows:

Section 1. Property to be Annexed. The corporate limits of the City are hereby amended to include the property and said property is hereby annexed to and included within the corporate limits of the City pursuant to Minnesota Statute §414.033 as if such property has originally been a part of the City.

Section 2. Appropriation of Filing Fee; Authorization to File Ordinance. The amount necessary to pay the filing fee required by the Minnesota Municipal Board for this annexation ordinance is hereby appropriated for such purpose, and the City Administrator is directed to make the necessary filings and provide required information to the Minnesota Municipal Board, the Township of Empire, the Auditor of Dakota County, and the Minnesota Secretary of State.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance is effective upon publication pursuant to Minnesota Statutes §412.191, Subdivision 4 and approval by the Minnesota Municipal Board.

That part of the NW½ of Section 32, Township 114, Range 19, Dakota County, Minnesota, described as follows: Commencing at the NW corner of said NW¼ of Section 32; thence South 89°50'12" East (assumed bearing) along the North line of said NW½ of Section 32 a distance of 59.45 feet; thence South 1°38'57" West a distance of 500.32 feet to a point on the southerly right of way line of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad Company and the easterly right of way line of State Trunk Highway No. 3, said southerly right of way line being 50.00 feet perpendicularly southerly of and parallel to the main track of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad Company as now located which is the point of beginning, then North 74°15'36" East along said south right of way line of railroad a distance of 1430.00 feet; thence South 15°44'24" East a distance of 466.00 feet; thence South 74°15'36" West a distance of 717.58 feet; thence North 87°35'18" West a distance of 819.20 feet, more or less, to the east right of way line of said State Trunk Highway No. 3; thence North 1°38'57" East along said east right of way line a distance of 220.88 feet to the point of beginning, according to the Government Survey thereof.
