

ORDINANCE NO. 93-8-2-2

"AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE
CITY OF LONG PRAIRIE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED
TERRITORY BORDERED BY LAND WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS
AND ABUTTING THEREON

WHEREAS, A certain territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the perimeter of this territory is completely surrounded by lands already included within the corporate limits of the city and is deemed to be urban or suburban in character;

WHEREAS, the area to be annexed does not exceed 200 acres; and,

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF LONG PRAIRIE ORDAINS:

Section 1. Territory annexed. The corporate limits of the City of Long Prairie, Minnesota are hereby extended to include the unplatted territory described as follows:

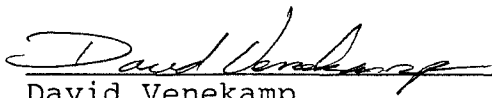
Beginning at the NE corner of Lot 1 Block 2 Oak Knoll Addition. E 392.55' S180' W392.55' N180' to beginning (20-129-33). (The land was the former Al Bense residence).

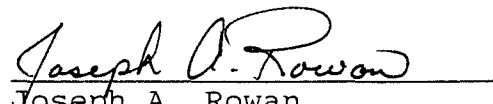
Section 2. Zoning. The land described herein will be zoned residential as defined in the City of Long Prairie's zoning ordinance.

Section 3. Filing. The City Administrator/Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of the County in which the property is located, the Town Clerk of the affected township and the Minnesota Municipal Board.

Section 4. Effective date of annexation. This ordinance takes effect upon passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 3 and approval by the Minnesota Municipal Board.

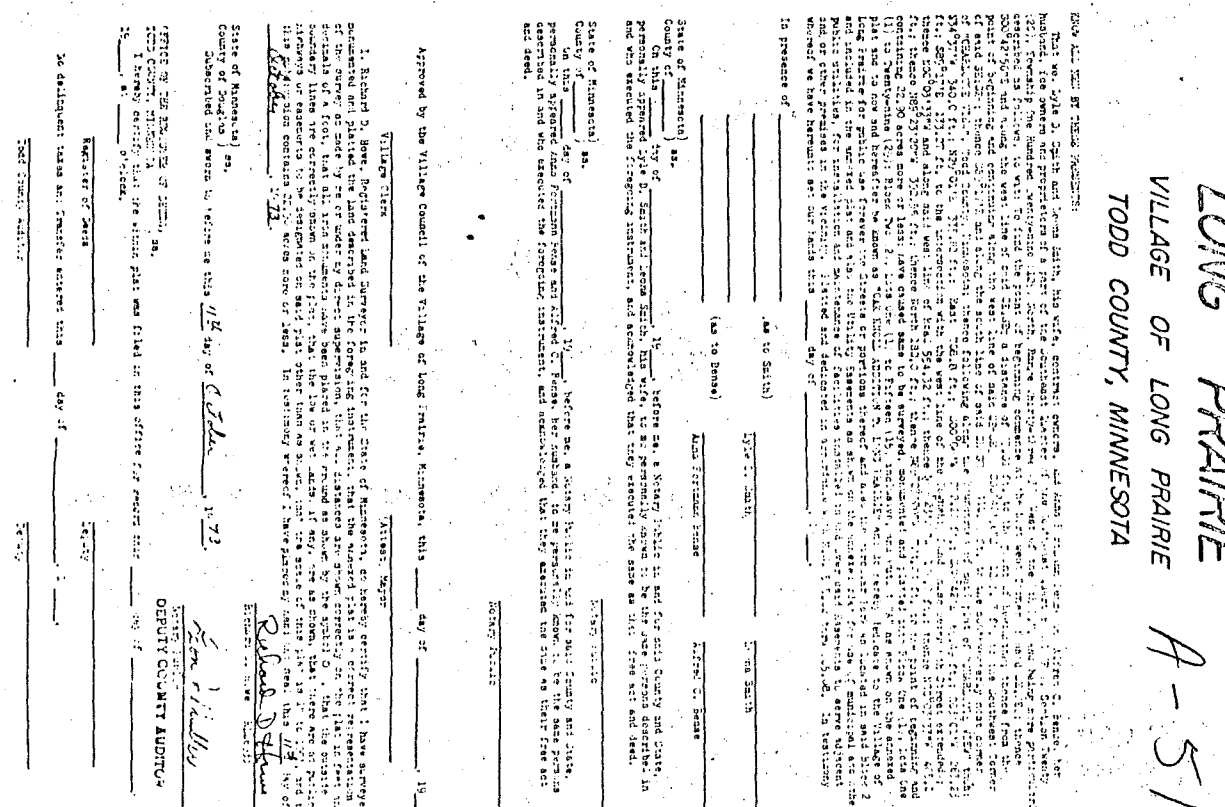
